Top 20 Biggest Recent Dips (Long-Term Healthy) — Generated July 07, 2026

Methodology

This report identifies stocks with the largest recent price dips using a composite score that blends four metrics: (1) drawdown from the trailing 30-day high, (2) 30-day simple return, (3) z-score of that return relative to the stock's own historical volatility, and (4) percentage below the 60-day moving average.

Long-Term Trend Filter: Stocks in sustained downtrends are excluded. Only stocks where at least one of the 1-year or 1.5-year returns is positive are included. This ensures we surface momentary dips in otherwise healthy stocks — not declining companies. A more negative composite score indicates a deeper, more statistically unusual dip. This is intended as a screening tool — further fundamental and technical analysis is recommended before making investment decisions.
