Top 20 Biggest Recent Surges — Generated July 07, 2026

Methodology

This report identifies stocks with the largest recent price surges using a composite score that blends four metrics: (1) rally from the trailing 30-day low, (2) 30-day simple return, (3) z-score of that return relative to the stock's own historical volatility, and (4) percentage above the 60-day moving average.

Extreme-Runner Filter: Stocks that have been in extreme multi-year uptrends (both 1-year and 1.5-year returns above +100%) are excluded to keep the focus on recent breakout surges rather than stocks that have simply been climbing for years. A higher composite score indicates a stronger, more statistically unusual surge. This is intended as a screening tool — further fundamental and technical analysis is recommended before making investment decisions.
